Day 1 : PASSAU

Day 2 : MELK - DURNSTEIN - VIENNA

We'll return on board in the afternoon before cruising on to Vienna. After our arrival, join us on an optional excursion : Tour Vienna by night.



Day 3 : VIENNA

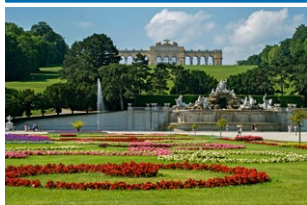


