Day 1: VALLETTA

Passengers are welcome to board our ship at 6 p.m. After comfortably settling into your cabins, we'll introduce our crew at a welcome cocktail before dinner on board. Enjoy an evening of entertainment.



Day 2: VALLETTA

Included excursion: Valletta in the morning. The splendid Maltese capital deserves a special visit. Perched on top of a steep cliff, its layout and architectural structures are remarkable. The city was built stone-by-stone by and for the Order of Knights of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem. We'll make an exclusive stop at Saint John's Co-Cathedral.

Free afternoon.

LA BELLE DE L'ADRIATIQUE will then raise its anchor and begin to cruise to Sicily. Join the ship's crew on the Sun Deck for a cocktail as we admire one of the most beautiful ports in the world on our way out.



Day 3: PORTO EMPEDOCLE

Included excursion this morning: Agrigento, one of the oldest Sicilian cities. You'll discover the Valley of the Temples, a monumental ensemble of Hellenic ruins. The site contains a series of impressive temples, statues, and tombs built by Greek settlers who began to arrive in the 8th century BC. The Temple of Concordia is considered one of the best-preserved Doric temples in the world. Afterwards, you'll discover Agrigento, a charming small city with cobblestone streets, beautiful churches, and picturesque squares.

We'll spend the afternoon cruising.



Day 4: TRAPANI

We'll spend the morning cruising.

This afternoon, join us for an included excursion: Trapani and the medieval village of Erice. Discover the beauty of Trapani, located at the western tip of Sicily. Explore the quaint city streets, admire the Ligny Tower, and take a stroll along the Mura di Tramontana, the ancient fortifications that once defended the area. Continuation towards Erice, a medieval gem perched 750 meters above sea level on Mount San Giuliano. You will be charmed by this picturesque village with its cobblestone streets, stone houses, and breathtaking panoramas of the Egadi Islands and the Tyrrhenian Sea.



Day 5: PALERM0

Included excursions:

This morning, visit Palermo. Discover Sicily's capital city—built in the shelter of a magnificent bay—with its ravishing palaces and magnificent gardens. Take a stroll through the historic center and have a look at the cathedral and its ornate, amber-colored stone exterior. We'll visit the Church of St. Mary of the Admiral (also known as Martorana). While it's unassuming on the outside, the inside is simply jaw-dropping.

This afternoon: Monreale. Monreale overlooks a fertile valley overflowing with olive, orange, and almond trees. Its rich history and cultural heritage come together in a mix of fantastic styles. You'll visit the superb cathedral, a Norman architectural masterpiece built in the 12th century.



Day 6: SALERNO

We'll spend the morning cruising.

This afternoon, join us for an included excursion: Sorrento and the Amalfi Coast. Discover the charming, hillside city of Sorrento, surrounded by orange and lemon orchards and a spectacular panorama



of the sea. Enjoy an Italian aperitivo and lunch in a local restaurant. Afterwards, we'll continue our trip and visit the villages along the dramatic Amalfi Coast filled with colorful houses and elegant seaside resorts.



Day 7: NAPLES

Included excursions:

Pompeii. A city frozen in time, which through its tragedy has become one of the most significant resources of information on Roman art, customs, trades, and life.

OR Herculaneum. Just like Pompeii, Herculaneum was also destroyed by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in AD 79. Discover the wealth of archaeological finds, from ancient advertisements and stylish mosaics to carbonized furniture and inhabitants. One of the most interesting sites is the house with the mosaic atrium.

Naples. Discover the must-see sites, masterful works, and unexpected treasures in Naples, such as its old town and royal palace. In the oldest section of Naples, enjoy a stroll down the Via San Gregorio Armeno, the famous pedestrian street where you can observe skilled craftsmen actually working on nativity figures as they carve and paint them. During the holidays, the atmosphere here becomes enchanted. We'll visit the Cloister of Santa Chiara to admire the nativity scene with 18th-century figurines.



Day 8: NAPLES

Enjoy breakfast on board this morning before disembarking at 9:00 a.m.
